No. F. 7-2/73-WEC-dated 26th September, 1975. To promote conservation of Wildlife in Pakistan, the Federal Government approved the setting up of a National Council for Conservation of Wildlife in Pakistan as under:—

2. FUNCTIONS:

- (a) Formulation of appropriate policies for the conservation of Wildlife in the country;
- (b) Coordination of the implementation of these policies by the Provinces/Local Governments; and
- (c) Liaison with International Agencies and non-Government Societies for Conservation of Wildlife.

3. COMPOSITION:

Chairman

Vice-Chairman

NON-OFFICIALS

Five non-official members to be appointed on the recommendations of the Provincial/Local Governments.

4. The terms of office and expenditure etc., will be as follows:—

(a) *Terms of Office:*

- (1) Non-official members of the Council shall hold office for a term of 2 years until resigned or removed by the Federal Government and will be eligible for renomination.
- (2) A non-official member may at any time resign his membership by writing under his hand to the Chairman. But the seat of such member shall be deemed to have fallen vacant from the date of acceptance of his resignation by the Chairman.

(b) *Meetings :*

The Council will hold at least one meeting in a year.

(c) *Expenditure :*

The expenditure on account of official members of the Council will be borne by the Central and Provincial/Local Governments concerned from which the member draws his pay—etc.. The non-official members of the Council will be disbursed their T.A./D.A. by the Council in connection with its meetings.

(d) *General :*

The Government reserve to themselves the right to make any changes in the Resolution at any time without notice.

5. This Ministry's Resolution No. F. 7-2-WEC, dated 2nd July, 1974 is hereby cancelled.

6. Ordered that the Resolution be published in the Gazette of Pakistan.

AMENDMENT

In Regulation 5, Sub-clause (C) of Clause (i) shall be deleted.

No. SOFT (FAD) V-168/71, dated 9th August, 1974: In exercise of the powers conferred on him by sub-section (1) of section 29 of the Forest Act, 1927, the Governor, North-West Frontier Province is pleased to declare that the provisions of Chapter IV of the said Act, shall, with immediate effect, be applicable to Government lands along roads, canals railways and forest land resumed by Government.

No. SOFT (FAD) V-168/71, dated 9th August, 1974: In exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 32, 68, 72 and 76 of the Forest Act, 1927 (Act XVI of 1927), the Governor, North-West Frontier Province is pleased to make the following rules, namely.

THE HARZA DISTRICT PROTECTED FOREST RULES, 1973

1. (1) These rules may be called the Hazara District Protected Forest Rules, 1973.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

(3) They shall apply to Government lands along roads, canals, Railways and forest lands resumed by Government.

2. In these Rules:—

(a) "Divisional Forest Officer" means Divisional Forest Officer, Incharge of the Division concerned; and

(b) "Conservator" means the Conservator of Forests, Incharge of the Conservancy Circle concerned.

3. (i) Cutting, sawing, conversion and removal of trees and timber and collection, manufacture and removal of other forest produce from the protected forest is prohibited, except as provided in these rules.

(ii) Cutting of trees from protected forest for commercial purpose shall be done under approved working plans/schemes and sale proceeds there of shall be credited to Government account as revenue of the Forest Department.

(iii) Resin tapping operations and collection of other Forest produce in the protected forest shall be organized by the Divisional Forest Officer on the pattern in vogue in reserved forests and the sale proceeds thereof shall be credited to Government account as revenue of the Forest Department.

4. Subject to the following conditions, the grant of trees for meeting bonafide domestic requirements of the residents of the villages within the boundaries of which the protected forest is situated shall rest with the Conservator:—

- (a) the removal of trees shall be subject to silvicultural availability;
- (b) request for grant of trees shall ordinarily be rejected if alternative sources for meeting such demands are available;
- (c) the grant of trees under this rule shall not be free but on concessional rates and subject to a maximum limit to be fixed by the Provincial Government on recommendations of the Conservator; and
- (d) the rates and number of trees fixed under clause (c) of this rule shall be reviewed periodically.

5. Collection of dry and fallen branches of trees by the local residents for bonafide domestic use as firewood may be permitted by the Conservator on such terms and conditions as he may impose from time to time.

6. Grazing of cattle and grass cutting in the protected forest may be permitted by the Conservator of the following conditions:

- (a) Grazing and grass cutting fee shall be charged at the rates fixed for reserved forests of the Forest Division concerned;
- (b) type of grazing animals to be allowed, their number and season during which grazing may be done shall be determined by the Divisional Forest Officer;
- (c) the Conservator may close any part of the protected forest to grazing and grass cutting for the purposes of regeneration and Conservation for period not exceeding 30 years; provided that in villages where there are no waste lands the area closed for grazing shall not exceed one-half of the total area of the protected forest. In villages where there are waste lands the maximum limit for closure to grazing shall be one half of the total area of the waste lands and the protected forest taken together.

7. The use of existing paths and springs shall be allowed in accordance with the current practices; provided that the Conservator may close an existing path after giving a notice which shall not be less than one month; and provided further that such closure shall be made only when an alternative path exists or has been provided for in the vicinity of the path so closed.

8. Quarrying for sand and stone, and digging of soil may be permitted by the

Divisional Forest Officer on terms and fees in vogue for similar activities in reserved forest of the Division concerned.

9. Burning of kilns for lime, surkhi or any other purpose is prohibited except for Government works or undertaking of general public utility, and for which a fee of Rs. 100 per kiln shall be charged.

10. Rules made for regulation and control of hunting, shooting, fishing, poisoning of water and setting traps or snares in reserved forests of the Division concerned shall also be applicable to the protected forest of that Division.

11. Duties and powers of the Forest Officer in relation to affairs of the protected forest not provided for specifically in these rules shall be the same as in case of the adjoining reserved forest.

12. Any person who infringes any of the provisions of these rules shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to six months, or the fine which may extend to five hundred rupees, or with both.

No. WL & FT (SOI) 13 (44)/1974: In pursuance of the policy directive of the Prime Minister and decision of the Inter-Provincial Conference taken at its meeting held at Lahore on April, 17th to 19th 1974, the Government of Sind, after careful consideration, have been pleased to abolish with immediate effect the existing contract system of exploitation of timber and fuel wood in the Government Reserved Protected Riverain Forests and Irrigated Forest Plantations.

The Government of Sind have been further pleased to order that the exploitation of timber and fuel wood (including all operations like felling, conversion, storage, transportation, marketing etc.) in aforesaid Government Forests shall henceforth be done Departmentally.

In order to implement the above policy, it has been decided to reorganise the existing administrative set-up of the Sind Forest Department on a functional basis and re-constitute the existing territorial forest circles headed by Conservators of Forests as shown in attached schedule I (new set up) and schedule II (old set up) with following broadly defined functions:—
